# OUR VISION, OUR VOICE: The New Image Makers

The Month Of Photography( MOP) event in Denver invites high school photography students to enter into a juried exhibit. The exhibit will be held in Denver at the Studios at Globeville Riverfront Art Center (GRACe) in the RiNo arts district during the month of March 2017. (March 3-26)

Awards will be given and the selected work will continue to be viewed on the MOP online gallery space.

#### Dates:

January 30: Entry form and jpeg of work due February 10: Applicants receive notification

February 25: Framed work due to GRACe (888 E 50th Ave, Denver, 80216)

March 3: Opening Reception

March 26: Show ends Mar. 27-April 1: Pick-up work

#### **Guidelines:**

- > Eligibility open to any currently enrolled high school photography student in the Denver Metro region.
  - > Limit: Each entrant may submit **one** photograph.
  - > The photograph must be original material taken by the entrant.
  - > Theme: No theme is dictated.
  - > Entry Fee: No entry fee required.
- > Medium: Digital or Analog (film & darkroom based, alternative processes such as pinhole, cyanotypes, image transfers, etc.)
- > Size: Framed work up to 20" X 24". Work must abide by the following criteria:
  - White Mat
  - Black frame & glass, with metal edge corners and sturdy wire (i,e: Nielsen or similar). Poster or weak frames are unacceptable.
     Work submitted that does not have an adequately strong frame & hanging wire will be eliminated from the exhibit.
- ➤ Objectionable (obscene, profane or disrespectful) content will not be considered and such determination is solely at the discretion of the judges and GRACe.
- > Release: If portraits are submitted, entrants should obtain permission from all persons who appear.

- > Each entrant retains the copyright to his/her Photograph but explicitly grants MOP and GRACe Gallery license for any and all media .
- Students may price their work for sale. GRACe Gallery may take a commision on all work sold (exact percentage will be updated shortly)
- ➤ Entry must be submitted in digital format through our online entry form. To enter, visit <a href="http://denvermopteenshow.weebly.com/">http://denvermopteenshow.weebly.com/</a> and complete the entry form by January 30.

# **Entry Requirements:**

- > Digital submission **must** abide by the following criteria:
  - o 2 MB or smaller
  - JPEG or JPG format
  - File Name labeled as: mopteen\_lastname.jpg example-mopteen\_smith.jpg (If file is not labeled correctly or any of the above criteria is not followed, work will be eliminated from judging)

# **Judging Criteria:**

- > Photographic Quality & Craftsmanship
  - Composition
  - Exposure, Contrast, Appropriate Focus
  - For silver gelatin prints-no scratches, dust
- > Creativity
- Overall visual impact
- Personalization/originality

### **Acceptance Information:**

If your piece is accepted into the exhibit, upon notification, you will be sent reminders for frame specifications, drop off ,opening reception and pick up dates, & directions to the gallery.
