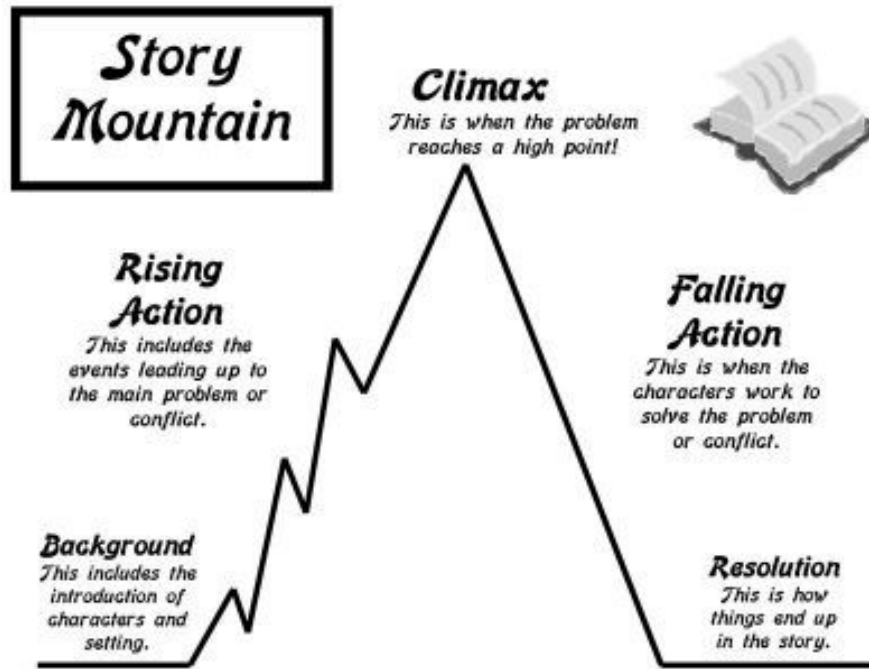

**Panel 1: Exposition:** Should show the characters
